Appeals Process

It is the desire of the Board of Directors that all decisions made are a representation of the majority of the community.

The following document will serve as a guideline to the process, by which a member of the Avondale Groves Homeowners Associates may appeal decisions made by the Architectural Committee and/or Board of Directors.

Step One- Board of Directors Appeal

A member of the Avondale Groves Homeowners Association who disagrees with a decision made by the Architectural Committee or Board of Directors should first schedule with the Secretary of the Board of Directors time to be added to the agenda of the next Board of Directors meeting. This time will be allotted for the member to professionally present their disagreement to the Board of Directors for consideration. If the Board of Directors further denies the request of the member, then the member has the option of proceeding to step two of the appeals process.

Step Two- Community Petition

This step in the appeals process requires the member to draft a document that outlines their request which was denied by the Board of Directors. That document should then be taken to other members of the Avondale Groves Homeowners Association in an attempt to gain the approval of the majority of the community by having members sign and place their address on the document. If the member obtains the support of the majority of the Avondale Groves Homeowners Association, as outlined in our governing documents, then the member should contact the Secretary to request that time be scheduled on the agenda of the next Board of Directors meeting. This time will be allotted for the member to professionally present the community petition.
